Richard G. Ligon was instrumental in establishing the Ronald McDonald House in Lubbock. He served on the RMHC board from 1984 to 2007. His dedication prompted the establishment of the Richard Ligon

Ronald McDonald House Service Award and was the inaugural award recipient. He was active in McDonald's Corp., serving as chairman of the Regional Purchasing committee and was awarded the Ronald McDonald Award in 1988. His legacy will live on as RMHC continues to keep families close, however, he will be missed.
